



CALL TO ACTION FOR BC MEDIA OUTLETS TO HELP US SOUND THE ALARM, EXPOSE THE TRUTH, AND SAVE A LIFE

Vancouver, BC – The ugly truth of the matter is that the adult epilepsy system in BC is a black mark on the Canadian health care system.

Two more episodes of the What If ... Documentary Series™ are set to be launched, including an episode on Allison Hegedus and an episode on **Mackenzie MacWilliams**, who passed away from Sudden Unexpected Death in Epilepsy (SUDEP).

Both the What If ... Documentary Series™ and the Roll Call campaign have come out of necessity after Kim Davidson, CEO & Executive Director of the BC Epilepsy Society made 8 meeting requests and painstakingly waited 26 months for a meeting with government to discuss the issues.

Both Jared Ricks and Mackenzie MacWilliams were still alive when Kim was asking for these meetings with the Minister of Health, Adrian Dix.

The Roll Call campaign engages all candidates running in the 2020 BC Provincial Election to ensure they are made aware of the epic failures in the adult epilepsy program in our province.

“We have had incredible uptake from over 70 candidates from the BC Liberal Party, the BC Green Party and the BC Libertarian Party who have reached in and set meetings with us to discuss the structural failings of adult epilepsy sitting within Vancouver Coastal Health Authority when it should have provincial oversight within Provincial Health Services Authority,” stated Kim Davidson.

Kim added, “We have not yet had a single meeting with any candidate from the NDP Party. This will not stand. We urge all people living with and affected by epilepsy in BC to vote on October 24th for the candidates who have their interests at heart. We also urge any candidates who have not yet responded to our meeting request to participate in the Roll Call and meet with us to discuss the issues.”
